**Brelby Studio Costuming**  
**A Review from Tasha Cady**

A couple of weeks ago Chuck and I went to our second production at the Brelby (a tiny theater in downtown Glendale). The production was a new play, "She Kills Monsters!" with a D&D theme. The costuming of the female adventurers was delightful, and worked well with the body types. The previous production had been "The Importance of Being Earnest," done with steampunk styling. I would recommend keeping an eye out for future productions. The plays are amusing and the costuming is fun.

*Your editor saw "She Kills Monsters!" at a different performance. It was brilliantly funny and moving, well staged and well acted with a kind of Kevin Smith/Joss Whedon flavor to the*

dialogue and lots of 90's pop culture touchstones. The Brelby uses an intimate "Black Box" stage with the audience very close to the action. The set integrated dungeony platforms and walls. Clever use of rear-screen projection allowed the dungeon to be instantly transformed into a comic book shop or a high school guidance counselor's office. A stage ninja in a black body suit provided the special effects for magic users.

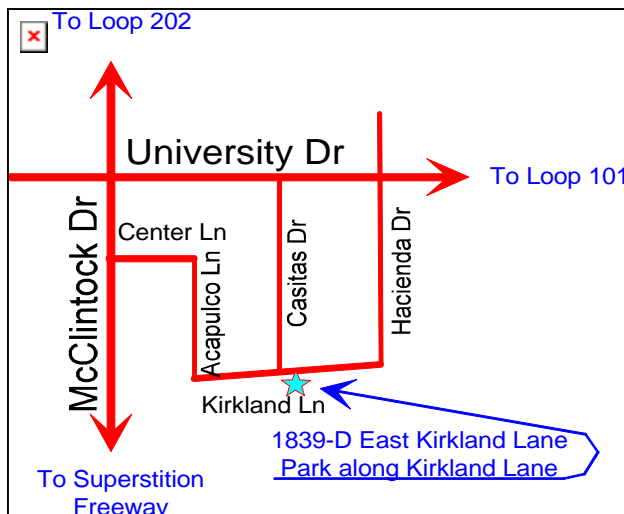
**Zombie Makeup Workshop at Theater Works**
